

Freedom of Information Act 2000 (Section 51) Information notice

Date: 8 October 2024

Public Authority: Home Office Address: 2 Marsham Street London SW1P 4DF

Section 51

Under section 51 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), which is set out below, the Information Commissioner (the Commissioner) has the power to serve a notice on a public authority requiring it to furnish him with any information he requires to enforce the requirements of FOIA.

- 51. (1) If the Commissioner -
 - (a) has received an application under section 50, ...

he may serve the authority with a notice (in FOIA referred to as "an information notice") requiring it, within such time as is specified in the notice, to furnish the Commissioner, in such form as may be so specified, with such information relating to the application, to compliance with Part I or to conformity with the code of practice as is so specified.

Application under section 50

1. The Commissioner has received an application under section 50, reference IC-306725-S0G1, for a decision whether a request for information made by the complainant to the Home Office on 17 November 2023, has been dealt with in accordance with the requirements of Part I of FOIA.



Nature of complaint

- 2. The Commissioner wrote to the Home Office on 14 August 2024, setting a 20 working day deadline to provide a copy of the withheld information and its justification for applying exemptions.
- 3. On 13 September 2024, the Home Office contacted the Commissioner and asked for the deadline to be extended to 27 September 2024. The Commissioner agreed to this extension. However, he explained that he would issue an information notice if he did not receive the Home Office's response by that date.
- 4. The Home Office contacted the Commissioner on 27 September 2024 to ask for a further extension, saying that it hoped to be in a position to respond by the end of the following week (ie by 4 October 2024).
- 5. As of the date of this notice, no such response has been received from the Home Office.

Information required

- 6. In view of the matters described above the Commissioner hereby gives notice that in the exercise of his powers under section 51 of FOIA he requires that the Home Office shall, within 30 calendar days of the date of this notice, furnish the Commissioner with a copy of the following information:
 - A copy of any information that the Home Office still wishes to withhold in respect of this request.
 - A substantive response to the Commissioner's letter of 14 August 2024.

Failure to comply

7. Failure to comply with the steps described above may result in the Commissioner making written certification of this fact to the High Court (or the Court of Session in Scotland) pursuant to section 54 of FOIA, and may be dealt with as a contempt of court.



Right of appeal

8. There is a right of appeal against this information notice to the First-tier Tribunal (Information Rights). Information about the appeals process can be obtained from:

9. Any Notice of Appeal should be served on the Tribunal within 28 (calendar) days of the date on which this information notice is sent. If Notice of Appeal is served late the Tribunal will not accept it unless it is of the opinion that it is just and right to do so by reason of special circumstances.
