I'm concerned with verbal requests. There are a number of issues. The identify of that data subject must firstly be ensured. Secondly, there is too much scope for ambiguity and error. One party may understand that they have made a request but the other may not understand it to be so. Thirdly, it may be difficult to prove that an access request has been made verbally, resulting in undue conflict and unnecessary delay. I would suggest that all data subject requests are directed to the DPO, whose contact details are required to be available. The DPO contact could be logged by the individual themselves or by customer services on behalf of the individual. That way, there's a controlled point of entry for all requests.
