	We receive a lot of requests under SAR whilst investigations are ongoing, for example a complaint is made against a staff member that is actively being investigated. In the course of natural justice that information will be disclosed at the appropriate time but quite often staff or students are trying to find things out outside of due process - either to make contact with the complainant themselves or to undermine the process. The investigations are very rarely to do with crime/taxation but it is clear that early disclosure would inhibit the fairness of internal investigation process (disciplinary/grievance) and the guidance doesn't cover the exemptions that should be applied in those circumstances.
