Request

You asked us:

"1. I would like to read any data that the Information Commissioner's Office holds on constraints - legal, or otherwise, (eg guidance) on FOIA responders using, or adding, personal information into responses to FOIA requests.

2. I would like to know if - and how - the Information Commissioner's Office has dealt with any personal information included in a response to a FOIA REQUEST before."

We received your request on 23 May 2023.

We have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOIA).

Our response

I have consulted with the relevant areas of the ICO and can confirm that we hold the information in scope. All of the information has been withheld under section 12 of the FOIA.

The Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004 states that the 'appropriate limit' for the ICO is \pounds 450. We have determined that \pounds 450 would equate to 18 hours work.

We regularly include personal data of individuals in FOIA responses, for example the names of individuals in emails, however to determine 'how the ICO has dealt with any personal information' in the past would require us to manually review over 2000 FOIA cases.

If it were to take 3 minutes to review each case, and this is a very conservative estimate, then it would take in excess of 100 hours to gather the information which would allow us to definitely answer your question.



Section 12 of the FOIA applies to the whole response, not just the section that takes the request over the appropriate cost limit.

Advice and assistance

I do not think we would be able to narrow the scope of the second part of your request, as it would ultimately involve manually reviewing all FOIA responses that the ICO has provided. It would be of limited value to you to narrow the date range of the request, as the information would not a complete reflection of how we have handled personal data in the past.
